Performance Competition - General Information

To recognise members' efforts in promoting the breed by entering competitions the Council will donate a silver medal for the Ridden and In Hand horse gaining most points during the season. Publicity will be given in the Spring/Summer Newsletter and the award will be made at an appropriate venue.

CONDITION OF ENTRY

- * The horse (filly, colt, mare, stallion or gelding) must be registered with the IDHS(NZ)
- * The owner / competitor must be a financial member of the IDHS(NZ)
- * The competition shall run from 1st September each year to 31st August the following year.
- * All "Ridden Competition" horses must only gain their points from competitions under saddle (Turnout and Best Rider classes are ineligible)
- * Competition scores can be backdated for late entries
- * Horses sold during the year may have their scores transferred to the new owner on application to the Secretary and provided the new owner is or becomes, a member of the I.D.H.S.(NZ)
- * Entries must be made on official score sheet and be accompanied by the \$10.00 entry
- * Score sheet must be returned to the performance co-ordinator no later than 30th September each year.
- * The Council reserves the right to delete any competition which it considers ineligible for this competition and to check results with show/events it considers necessary.

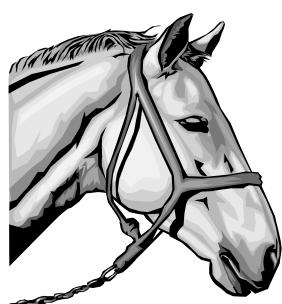
AN HONESTY SYSTEM WILL OPERATE
